All members of the Keynotes are also members of one of the other musical ensembles at Olentangy High School.

During the 2010-2011 season, the Keynotes competed at Beavercreek (1st Runner-Up), Fairfield (5th Runner-Up), Grove City (Grand Champions), and even traveled to New York City for a National Show Choir Competition!
